Tools Changes

Streamlined Packaging, Improved Access to Softcopy

- Starting in June 2002, collections containing both BookManager and PDF files include an index to just the PDF files in the collection. The index is available in both HTML and text formats (PDFINDEX.HTM and PDFINDEX.TXT) in the root directory of the discs containing the softcopy files.
- Starting in March 2002, you can set autorun preferences for the programs to run when a collection disc is inserted in your disc drive. For example, you can choose to automatically start Softcopy Reader, the softcopy index for the entire collection, or the softcopy index for a single disc when you insert a disc containing softcopy files. Or, you can choose not to have anything start automatically. See "Setting Autorun Preferences for Collection Discs" on page 29 for more information.

To provide more options for accessing softcopy, multi-disc collections include softcopy indexes for each disc in the collection, as well as a softcopy index for the entire collection.

- Starting in June 2001, the softcopy collection index for a multi-disc collection is automatically displayed when you insert any of the discs other than the tools disc.
- Starting in September 2000, many IBM softcopy collections include a program to simplify installation of softcopy tools and improve access to the softcopy collection index files included on the collections. Here are the highlights of these redesigned collections:
 - Instead of hardcopy collection indexes (booklets), softcopy versions are provided in the root directory of each disc.
 - Instead of a hardcopy version of the *Installing, Managing, and Using the Online Library* book, softcopy versions are provided in the root directory of each disc.
 - For multi-disc collections, all the softcopy tools are on a separate tools disc, instead of on each disc. For single-disc libraries and collections, the tools are on the same disc as the softcopy publications.
 - A program helps you install or update softcopy tools.

This install program runs only on Windows 95 (or later), or on Windows NT 4.0 (or later). Users of other operating systems can still install or update the softcopy tools and view the softcopy versions of the collection index and the *Installing, Managing, and Using the Online Library* book directly.

IBM Softcopy Reader and IBM Library Readers

The program is also available on this collection in the **ilrjava** directory. The level of the code on this collection is the one that was available when this collection was built.

- For an introduction to Softcopy Reader, see the Softcopy Reader chapter in *Installing, Managing, and Using the Online Library*, GC31-8311. For details, see the softcopy version of the *Softcopy Reader User's Guide*, SC34-3164, which is in the IBM Online Library Reference Bookshelf.
- Starting in March 2001, the IBM Library Readers for Windows, OS/2, and DOS are not being shipped on softcopy collections, and are no longer supported. Instead, only the IBM Softcopy Reader is included on the collections.

The IBM Library Readers will continue to be available as-is from the BookManager Web site for those users who choose to continue to use them.

- Starting in September 2001, the Softcopy Receiver Tool (SCRT) is no longer supported. It is being shipped for the last time on the September and October 2001 softcopy collections. Use the SoftCopy Librarian (SCL) instead.

SCL for OS/2 is no longer supported and is provided on an as-is basis. The product code is available for downloading from:

- Starting in June 2001, the Java version of the SoftCopy Librarian, IBM SoftCopy Librarian V4.0 for Windows 95 and NT, is available.

Other Changes

- This collection does not include the hardcopy versions of the collection booklet (this document) and the *Installing, Managing, and Using the Online Library* book.

Softcopy versions are provided in BookManager, PDF, HTML, and ASCII (text) formats in the root directory of each disc in this collection (including the tools disc). The collection booklet is now called the *softcopy collection index*.

To improve access to the softcopy collection index, discs containing the softcopy libraries on this collection now include a program to set autorun preferences for the programs to run when a collection disk is inserted. One of the available options is to open the softcopy collection index.

For details on using the various formats of the softcopy collection index, see Chapter 4, "Locating Books in This Collection" on page 29.

If you need hardcopy versions of these books, you can print one of the softcopy formats, such as the PDF format.

- The graphics in BookManager BOOK files from June 2002 and earlier have been upgraded to improve viewing under BookServer and Softcopy Reader. This upgrade increased the size of the affected files, resulting in the reorganization of some softcopy collections.

Other than this increase in size, the change is transparent. The upgrade did not disturb the original build date and time stamp of the affected BOOK files.

None of the existing shelves and indexes are affected by the replacement of these BOOK files.

The upgrade primarily affects BOOK files that were built with host versions of the BookManager Build products and that contain graphic figures and illustrations. The original graphics were copied, converted into a Web-ready format, and inserted into the BOOK files for use with BookServer and Softcopy Reader. The original graphics still remain for viewing on host platforms. To benefit from the upgraded graphics, you should upgrade to the latest release of Softcopy Reader, Version 2.3.6 or later.

Chapter 1. Getting Started with This Collection

This is the *z/OS Security Server RACF Collection*, September 2002, SK3T-4272-04. It contains the RACF books from the z/OS Collection plus software product books from z/OS Software Products Collection that contain substantial RACF information regardless of the software products to which they apply. It also contains code samples. Using this collection, you can put a large number of IBM books online and access them without handling individual sets of books and libraries on many CD-ROMs and tapes.

This is an IBM Online Library collection. The books in this collection are formatted for display using BookManager BUILD. They can be viewed at your workstation or terminal using any of the following methods.

- The IBM Softcopy Reader, provided at no charge with the library
- AS/400 InfoSeeker, which is provided as a part of the Operating System/400 in Version 3
- Any of the IBM BookManager READ licensed programs for z/VM or or VM
- The IBM BookManager READ component of z/OS or OS/390

This softcopy collection index contains listings of the contents of the collection. It also contains information to help you determine the size of the online books, indexes, and shelves you need to use, as well as hints for customizing and distributing the Online Library to other workstations in your enterprise. *Installing, Managing, and Using the Online Library*, GC31-8311, included with this collection in softcopy, in the root directory and in the IBM Online Library Reference Bookshelf, will help you install and use the collection on your Windows, OS/2, or DOS workstation using this collection, and the IBM Softcopy Reader in it, as a starting point. If you have already installed an IBM Online Library on your workstation or host, you can use the books in this collection with your library as you would use the books in any collection that is part of the IBM Online Library.

For information on using this collection with the IBM reader programs, refer to the IBM Online Library Reference Bookshelf included in this collection.

Chapter 4. Locating Books in This Collection

Several aids in this collection can help you find books.

- A program to set autorun preferences for collection discs (see “Setting Autorun Preferences for Collection Discs”)
- For each disc containing BookManager files, an all-disc bookshelf for searching the content of all books on that disc (see “All-Disc Bookshelf” on page 30)
- Various formats of the softcopy collection index for searching the titles, order numbers, and file names of softcopy files on the collection (see “Softcopy Collection Index” on page 30)

Note: The softcopy collection index is an online guide to this collection.

Setting Autorun Preferences for Collection Discs

This collection includes a program to set autorun preferences for the programs to run when a collection disc is inserted. For example, you can choose to automatically start Softcopy Reader, the softcopy index to the entire collection, or the softcopy index for a single disc. Or, you can choose not to have anything start automatically.

The program (SETUP.EXE) runs automatically the first time you insert a disc that contains it. A window opens where you can select the autorun preferences for each type of collection disc. These are the preferences you can set:

- **For discs containing only BookManager files:**
 - Open the IBM Softcopy Reader.
 - Open the disc index.
 - Open the collection index.
 - Do not start any programs.
 - Show the autorun preferences window.
- **For discs containing only PDF files:**
 - Open the disc index.
 - Open the collection index.
 - Do not start any programs.
 - Show the autorun preferences window.
- **For discs containing both BookManager and PDF files:**
 - Open the IBM Softcopy Reader.
 - Open the disc index.
 - Open the collection index.
 - Do not start any programs.
 - Show the autorun preferences window.

To set your autorun preferences:

1. For each type of collection disc, select an autorun preference.

Use the selection list or Back and Next buttons to select the type of collection disc.

2. When you are done, click the Finish button.

You can preview a preference before setting it by clicking on one of the "Open... now" buttons.

After you save these preferences, the program does not run again unless you have set a preference to run it.

To change your preferences after initially setting them, do one of the following:

- If you are already viewing the collection index (on a disc other than the tools disc), click on the link to SETUP.EXE in the tips section.
- Otherwise, go to the root directory of a collection disc (other than the tools disc) and run SETUP.EXE.

All-Disc Bookshelf

If you haven't narrowed your search to a product library or book but you know which disc to look on, the *All-Disc* bookshelf on that disc can help you find the book you need. After inserting the disc, go to the bookshelf titled *All-Disc x Bookshelf* and use it to search the contents of all the BookManager BOOK files on the disc. This search can take substantial time because you might be searching the contents of several hundred books.

Softcopy Collection Index

This collection includes four formats of a softcopy collection index to help you locate specific books and bookshelves. The available formats are:

- **HTML:** For viewing with a Web browser. For more information about using the HTML file, see "HTML Format of Softcopy Collection Index."
- **BookManager:** For viewing and searching with the IBM Softcopy Reader. For more information about using the BookManager file, see "BookManager BOOK Format of Softcopy Collection Index" on page 33.
Note: When you select the BookManager format, you might see a warning message prompting you to select whether to open the file or save it to disk. Select *Open it*. Also, to view BookManager files without being interrupted by this warning, uncheck the box *Always ask before opening this type of file*, which is also displayed in this warning message.
- **PDF:** For viewing and printing with an Adobe Acrobat Reader. For more information about using the PDF file, see "PDF Format of Softcopy Collection Index" on page 34.
- **Text (ASCII):** For viewing with a workstation file viewer. For more information about using the TXT file, see "ASCII Text File Format of Softcopy Collection Index" on page 35.

HTML Format of Softcopy Collection Index

The HTML file for the catalog portion of the softcopy collection index is called SCINDEX.HTM. It is in the root directory of each disc in this collection. You can view this file with a Web browser. Netscape and Internet Explorer are two popular browsers. While viewing this HTML file, you can scroll through it or search for an order number, keyword, or phrase in the title of a specific book or bookshelf.

You can set up your browser to link to the books on the CD after you locate the book you want. If you do not set up your browser for links to BookManager files, you can still view and search the HTML file to locate the disc that the book is on.

To use SCINDEX.HTM, do the following:

- 1 Insert any numbered disc from this collection into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2 Do **one of** the following:
 - If you have set your autorun preferences to open the collection index for the type of disc you inserted, your browser automatically displays SCINDEX.HTM.
 - Otherwise, go to the root directory and open SCFRAME.HTM, which displays SCINDEX.HTM as part of SCFRAME.HTM.

- 3 When viewing SCINDEX.HTM, you can do any of the following:
 - Scroll through SCINDEX.HTM to find what you want.
 - Use the Find function to find the order number, keyword, or phrase in a book or bookshelf title.

Note: You might get more than one hit for the same book, because a book might be listed in more than one place.

- 4 When you have determined which disc the book is on, replace the disc you are looking at with the correct disc, if necessary.

- 5 Do **one of** the following:

If you have set up your browser for links to BookManager files: Click on the link in SCINDEX.HTM to open the book.

Notes:

- a. For instructions on setting up your browser, see “Setting Up Your Browser to Link to the Books on the CD.”
- b. In SCINDEX.HTM, when you click on a link to a book, you might see a warning message prompting you to select whether to open the file or save it to disk. Select **Open** it. To view files without being interrupted by this warning, uncheck the box **Always ask before opening this type of file**.

If you have not set up your browser links to BookManager files: Proceed as usual to locate and open the book with IBM Softcopy Reader.

Setting Up Your Browser to Link to the Books on the CD

You can use the HTML collection index without setting up your browser to link to the BookManager files. However, although you will be able to read what is on each disc in the collection, you will not be able to open the books from the softcopy index.

To link to and open the BookManager files from the HTML file, your browser preferences must specify which program it should use to open files with the various BookManager file extensions (BKS, BKSHELF, BKI, BKINDEX, BOO, and BOOK).

If you want your browser to link to BookManager files, first install the IBM Softcopy Reader. You can use the install program provided with this collection to install the reader.

Note: Regardless of how you install the IBM Softcopy Reader, make sure to shut down and restart your browser afterwards. This insures that the browser will invoke the IBM Softcopy Reader to open BookManager files.

Using SCINDEX.HTM on Your Desktop or on a Server

After transferring softcopy files from a collection to your desktop or a server, you might want to provide the same access to these files as you have when SCINDEX.HTM is loaded within the SCFRAME.HTM frameset on a collection disc. Here are some tips for doing this.

- Copy the contents of the root directory and \AUTOHTML directory from a numbered disc in the desired collection to your computer or server, using the same directory structure as on the collection.

For example, you could create a directory called \IBMBOOKS and nest the copied directories under it. Copy the files from the root directory of the collection into this top-level directory, and copy the contents of the \AUTOHTML directory of the collection disc into the \AUTOHTML directory under your top-level directory.

You should end up with a directory structure similar to this:

```
IBMBOOKS
|
-- > BOOKS
|
-- > SHELVES
|
-- > AUTOHTML
```

- If you copy the contents of several collection discs to a local repository, delete the DISC.JS and CHKDISC.JS files from the \AUTOHTML directory on your system, and delete DISC.HTM from the top-level directory (such as IBMBOOKS). Deleting these files enables the SCINDEX.HTM file to work as if the softcopy files it links to are all on one disc.
- The links in SCINDEX.HTM assume that the book and bookshelf files are in the \BOOKS and \SHELVES directories, and the PDF files are in the \PDF directory. If you moved the files into other directories, you must edit the links in SCINDEX.HTM to point to those directories.
- The links assume that you are using SCINDEX.HTM and the files it links to (books, bookshelves, PDFs) from the same drive. There might be situations when you cannot do this. For instance, if you are linking to books that are accessible on a server, you must change the links to match the drive letter on which the linked-to files are mounted.
- To create a desktop shortcut for launching SCFRAME.HTM from within your top-level directory (such as \IBMBOOKS):
 1. Right-click SCFRAME.HTM.
 2. Drag it to your desktop.
 3. Select the option to Create Shortcut Here.
- Each time the collection is updated, refresh your repository from the contents of the root directory and \AUTOHTML directory of the collection discs. The interface

is constantly being improved, and this is the only way to be assured of getting the latest code.

BookManager BOOK Format of Softcopy Collection Index

The BookManager format of the complete softcopy collection index is provided in two locations, under two different filenames. (Other than the filenames, the two files are identical.)

- The copy accessible from the root directory or through SCFRAME.HTM is called SCINDEX.BOO. It is in the root directory of each disc in the collection.
- The other copy is called EZ2ZRB23.BOO. It is located in its own bookshelf on each disc in the collection, other than the tools disc (if a separate tools disc is provided). For example, in the OS/390 Collection the bookshelf is called “Booklet for OS/390 Collection.”

The BookManager format provides the best search function of all the formats. It can also be used to print selected sections of the book, but the PDF format is recommended for printing large sections or an entire book.

You can view either copy of the BOOK file with IBM Softcopy Reader (on your workstation), or with an IBM BookManager READ program (on the host). While viewing the BOOK file, you can scroll through it or search it for an order number, keyword, or phrase in the title of a specific book or bookshelf. If you locate the book you want, you can then see which disc it is on.

To use SCINDEX.BOO, do the following:

- 1 Insert any disc from this collection into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2 Do **one of** the following:
 - If you are viewing the HTML format of the collection index, go to “Other Formats” and select “BookManager.”
 - Otherwise, go to the root directory and open SCINDEX.BOO.
- 3 You can do any of the following:
 - Scroll through SCINDEX.BOO to find what you want.
 - Go directly to the section of SCINDEX.BOO titled “Catalog for *name* Collection” and scroll through the lists.
 - Search for an order number, keyword, or phrase in a book or bookshelf title.
Note: You might get more than one hit for the same book, because a book might be listed in more than one place.
- 4 When you have determined the disc the book is on, replace the disc you are looking at with the correct disc, if necessary.
- 5 Proceed as usual to locate and open the book.

To use EZ2ZRB23.BOO, do the following:

- 1 Insert any disc from this collection (other than the tools disc, if a separate tools disc is provided) into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2 Display the list of bookshelves. Do **one of** the following:
 - If you have set your autorun preferences to open the IBM Softcopy Reader for the type of disc you inserted, your browser automatically displays the list of bookshelves.
 - In a command prompt window, change to the drive letter of your CD-ROM drive and enter the command to start your reader or select its icon and list the bookshelves on the disc.

The list of bookshelves will appear.
 - Locate the BookManager icon.
 - Click on the start menu and select the BookManager reader.

The list of bookshelves will appear.
- 3 In the list of bookshelves, look for the bookshelf titled "Booklet for *name* Collection."
- 4 Open the bookshelf.
- 5 Open the booklet.
- 6 You can do any of the following:
 - Scroll through the booklet to find what you want.
 - Go directly to the section of the booklet titled "Catalog for *name* Collection" and scroll through the lists.
 - Search for an order number, keyword, or phrase in a book or bookshelf title.

Note: You might get more than one hit for the same book, because a book might be listed in more than one place.
- 7 When you have determined the disc the book is on, replace the disc you are looking at with the correct disc, if necessary.
- 8 Refresh the bookshelf view in Bookshelf Organizer and proceed as usual to locate and open the book.

Note: If you are using Softcopy Reader 2.3.5 or later, the bookshelf view is automatically refreshed by default.

PDF Format of Softcopy Collection Index

The PDF file for the complete softcopy collection index is called SCINDEX.PDF. It is in the root directory of each disc in this collection. From the PDF file you can print high-quality output that looks very similar to printed books received from IBM.

You can view the PDF file with an Adobe Acrobat Reader. While viewing the PDF file, you can scroll through it or find an order number, keyword, or phrase in the title of a specific book or bookshelf. If you locate the book you want, you can then see which disc it is on.

To use SCINDEX.PDF, do the following:

- 1 Insert any disc from this collection into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2 Display SCINDEX.PDF. Do **one of** the following:
 - If you are viewing the HTML format of the collection index, go to “Other Formats” and select “PDF.”
 - Locate the icon for Adobe Acrobat Reader on your desktop or program list, then open SCINDEX.PDF from the root directory of the disc in the CD-ROM drive.
 - Go to the root directory and open SCINDEX.PDF.
- 3 You can do any of the following:
 - Scroll through SCINDEX.PDF to find what you want.
 - Use the Search function of the Adobe Acrobat Reader to find the order number, keyword, or phrase in a book or bookshelf title.

Note: You might get more than one hit for the same book, because a book might be listed in more than one place.
- 4 When you have determined which disc the book is on, replace the disc you are looking at with the correct disc, if necessary.
- 5 Refresh the view and proceed as usual to locate and open the book.

ASCII Text File Format of Softcopy Collection Index

The ASCII file for the catalog portion of the softcopy collection index is called SCINDEX.TXT. It is in the root directory of each disc in this collection. You can view it with your usual text editor or word processor, such as Notepad. While viewing SCINDEX.TXT, you can scroll through it or find an order number, keyword, or phrase in the title of a specific book or bookshelf. If you locate the book you want, you can then see which disc it is on.

To use SCINDEX.TXT, do the following:

- 1 Insert any disc from this collection into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2 Display SCINDEX.TXT. Do **one of** the following:
 - In a command prompt window, change to the drive letter of your CD-ROM drive and enter the command to start your usual text editor or word processor.
 - Locate the icon for your usual text editor or word processor.
 - Click on the start menu and select your text editor.
- 3 You can do any of the following:
 - Scroll through SCINDEX.TXT to find what you want.
 - Find the order number, keyword, or phrase in a book or bookshelf title.

Note: You might get more than one hit for the same book, because a book might be listed in more than one place.

- 4 When you have determined which disc the book is on, replace the disc you are looking at with the correct disc, if necessary.
- 5 Refresh the view and proceed as usual to locate and open the book.

Hierarchical File System Utility

The IRRHFSU utility unloads hierarchical file system (HFS) file data in a way that is complimentary to IRRDBU00. It can report on files residing within the currently mounted file system structure. It runs in the shell and creates a record for every file or directory in the HFS subtree. It unloads the FSP data and additional data provided by the C stat() routine, as well as the contents of any ACLs that might exist for the file or directory. The utility comes with sample load and table definitions for use with DB2. You can also use the IRRHFSU utility to delete ACL entries containing UIDs and GIDs that cannot be mapped to RACF user or group profiles. This ability corresponds to the ability of the IRRRID00 utility to delete references to users and groups that no longer exist in the RACF database. For more information on this utility and for installation instructions, see the README file, HFSUnloadReadMe.pdf.

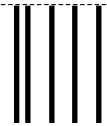

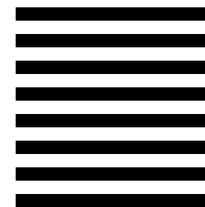
